K-12 School Day Start Time

AN ACT

An act providing that all Pennsylvania elementary and secondary public schools may not begin class before 9:00 AM.

- Section 1. This act shall be known as the Public School Sleep Act.
- Section 2. Beginning August 1, 2020, no Pennsylvania elementary or secondary public school may begin classroom instructional periods before 9:00 AM. All current requirements of 900 classroom instructional hours for elementary education and 990 classroom instructional hours for secondary education shall remain in effect.

Section 3. Effective Date: This act shall take effect on August 1, 2020.
