## **Mandatory One-Year Teen Driver Learner's Permit**

#### AN ACT

An act providing a one year driver learner's permit requirement for all teen drivers.

- Section 1. This act shall be known as the Teen Driver Safety Act.
- Section 2. Definitions. Teen Driver. A teen driver is any driver under 18 years of age.
- Section 3. All teen drivers must obtain a learner's permit and hold the learner's permit for a minimum of one year before they can take the road test for the junior driver's license as part of the Pennsylvania Graduated Licensing Program. All other Pennsylvania Graduated Licensing Program requirements, including the 16 year old age requirement for the permit, parental consent form, medical physical examination form, proof of identity, and written knowledge test remain in effect.
- Section 4. Effective Date: This act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
