Then, Senators will divide into Senate committees to discuss bills, take positions on legislation, and actually draft legislation for the full Senate to consider. Committees will include Transportation, Intergovernmental Operations Committee, Education Committee, Judiciary Committee, and Finance Committee. Bills to be considered:

#### Transportation Committee:

Senate Bill 7 – Unauthorized Use of an Electronic Tracking Device

Senate Bill 10 – Protecting from Central Bank Digital Currency
