Whole Milk in Schools

An Act authorizing the sale of Pennsylvania whole milk in schools.

Section (1). A school board or other governing entity of a Pennsylvania school may use state or local funds to obtain and offer for sale whole or reduced-fat Pennsylvania milk to students and staff within the school.

Section (2). The Department of Agriculture, in coordination with the Department of Education, shall establish a program to promote the inclusion of whole or reduced-fat Pennsylvania milk in schools.

Section (3). Definition: "Pennsylvania milk." Raw milk produced by cows physically located within the Commonwealth, transported to and processed at a dairy processing facility within the Commonwealth, and intended for distribution to consumers within the state.

Section (4). This shall take effect in 60 days.
