Voter Identification to Vote

An Act mandating the presentation of identification at each election.

Section (1). A qualified elector shall provide a valid identification at each election in accordance with the following:

- a. When voting in person, the qualified elector shall present a valid identification before receiving a ballot to vote in person.
- b. When not voting in person, the qualified elector shall provide proof of a valid identification with his or her ballot.

Section (2). If a qualified elector does not possess a valid identification, he or she shall, upon request and confirmation of identity, be furnished with a government-issued identification at no cost.

Section (3). Definitions.

“Qualified elector.” An individual 18 years or older.

“Valid identification.” An unexpired government-issued identification.

Section (4). This shall take effect in 60 days.
