Repeal Closed Primaries

An Act repealing closed primaries in the Commonwealth.

Section (1). Those who are registered as an independent voter may vote in a primary election by choosing either a Republican ballot or Democrat ballot to cast their vote on.

Section (2). Definitions.

“Independent voter.” An unaffiliated voter who does not align themselves with a political party. This term does not include an individual who is registered to a political party.

Section (3). This shall take effect in 60 days.
