Unauthorized Use of an Electronic Tracking Device An act providing the offense of unauthorized use of an electronic tracking device; and providing for penalties.

Section 1. A person commits the offense of unauthorized use of an electronic tracking device when the person installs or places an electronic tracking device without consent, or causes an electronic tracking device to be installed or placed on the person or property of another person without consent, and uses the electronic tracking device to track the location of the other person within this Commonwealth.

Section 2. This act shall not apply to any individual who is authorized by and acting in compliance with any other law, regulation, or court order to track the location of another individual within this Commonwealth.

Section 3. As used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Electronic tracking device." An electronic or mechanical device that permits an individual to remotely determine or track the position and movement of another individual or the property of another individual.

Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
